I pray that your summer is going well. I am excited about our new bible study on Tuesday nights.

The king was overjoyed and gave orders to lift Daniel out of the den. And when Daniel was lifted from the den, no wound was found on him, because he had trusted in his God. ~ Daniel 6:23

It is a look at the book of *Daniel* in the Old Testament through a video series by Beth Moore. I have enjoyed her teaching style for years. In this study, we consider the extraordinary life of Daniel as he thrives while in captivity in Babylon, is chosen and used by God, and is rescued by God from the lion's den. We will look at Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego as they enter the fiery furnace and later walk out untouched by smoke and flames. Daniel is a book of history and theology. Don't hesitate – come at least once and see what Tuesday night bible study is all about. We have a good group who are joining in, and we hope you will jump in and join us.

I am excited as well about beginning a new Wednesday night sermon series based on 1 Corinthians 13.

The activities the Nurture Committee organizes help us uplift each other, allow us to enjoy time together as a church family, and encourage us to spread Christ's love to others.

The following are currently members of the committee: Chairperson Bev Warfield, Cindy Fischer, Judy Tolk, Cheryl Good, Alan Good, Penny Flick, Jennifer Schuster, Nancy Weaver, Jackie Wirebaugh, and Pastor Sam Polito. Bev mentioned several times that all members are very devoted to making the committee all that it can be, and she wanted to take this opportunity to thank each one for all of their help and good ideas.

Currently, the Nurture Committee is involved in so many thoughtful activities. Each Sunday our church attendance is being taken and individuals are greeted by Cindy Fischer or Judy Tolk. Nurture has also reinstated scheduling greeters to welcome parishioners and guests at the doors – there is a sign-up sheet, and they are routinely encouraging volunteers to sign up. Birthday, get-well, and thinking-of-you cards are being sent out by the committee. They also send college care packages twice a year to our college students during final exams. Committee members often take meals to church members recovering from illness or similar situations. Cheryl and Alan Good have been doing a very good job of making calls. Lenten and Advent devotionals are handed out for these seasons during worship service. The committee also reinstituted giving of gifts for Mother's Day and Father's Day.

A picnic-style potluck lunch is planned for August 25 after the service, and a thankfulness dinner is in the works for November 10. Bev mentioned that committee members received many good comments about our two dinners so far, and that those comments were very much appreciated. Bev also shared that in past years, other functions, with positive results, had been planned and executed. She said listed a few that quickly came to mind. There had been progressive dinners - with appropriate courses planned, church members going from house to house, sharing food, and socializing before traveling to the next house. There also was a trivia night that benefitted the food pantry. There were game nights with snacks and members gathering in small groups, playing cards or other games. Church camping was a successful event that many enjoyed. And there was a Christian buddy program that was in place for several years.

The committee has discussed suggestions for future meetings/activities that include trivia night, game night, visitation to members not attending regularly, and encouraging members to join the prayer chain. Many fun activities could be planned again in the future. If you would be interested in any of these or if this has stirred other ideas, please share them with a Nurture Committee member. They are looking forward to doing all they can if there is interest.

I feel that we are a caring church primarily because of all the wonderful people like our Nurture Committee that are continually working behind the scenes. On behalf of the congregation, I say thank you and pray that you know your efforts and accomplishments are tremendously appreciated.
