

#### Come, Holy Spirit: A Prayer to the Holy Spirit

When we pray, we often pray as Jesus taught: "Our Father, who art in heaven". This is a good and biblical way to pray. We also pray to God, the Son. That's Jesus. We pray, "in Jesus' name". May the fruit of the Holy Spirit spring forth from our congregation and from our individual lives.

#### May 6 - Door Village Lions




