In November, we celebrate Thanksgiving, a day set aside to remember and give thanks to God. It is no coincidence that the month of November was selected to celebrate God's blessings. It is the month when crops are ready for harvest and food is most abundant. Food is stored for the coming winter, and...food is shared with those we love. As a Finance Committee, we are committed to ensuring sound financial management and stewardship of the resources that support the mission and ministry here at Door Village UMC. In the third quarter, our congregation's generosity and financial contributions have allowed us to maintain a stable financial position. Here is a brief update on our 2023 third quarter financials, as well as our 2023 year-to-date balance.

# 2023 3rd Ouarter

Total Revenue = \$43,679.08 Total Expenses = \$37,482.49 Net Change in Cash = \$6,196.59

### 2023 Year-to-Date

Total Revenue = \$126,191.79 Total Expenses = \$121,800.81 Net Change in Cash = \$4,390.98





