Sacrificial Giving: How can I do more to ensure the financial health of our church?

October kicks off the season we call Fall. October is a time of seeing the efforts of this past year come into focus. It has been a good year.

We have grown as a congregation. There are many new faces and families that have started attending church. You have done a great job of welcoming them. We have old friends that have found their way back to Door Village. They have shared with me how they feel welcomed and loved.

We have Sunday School going again. Tuesday evening bible study meets at 6 pm. Kids Club starts up their after-school program on Wednesdays beginning October 4. The choir rehearses Wednesdays at 6:30 pm to be ready to sing on Sundays. The youth group is doing its thing. So many great things are happening.

October is the month that our attention turns to harvest time. What we have planted begins to bear precious fruit. Traditionally, October is the month we set the slate of officers and leadership for the coming year. We prayerfully set the budget for the coming year and talk about faithful stewardship. We explore the many ways to give of our time, talents, gifts, service, and witness as Christian believers.

In years past, it was common to hold financial campaigns and commit ourselves to the work of the church. I want to lift up one area of ministry that is going through great change here at Door Village UMC. It used to be that our mission funds would come in from working hard at the county fair. So many hours and generous gifts would bring in money to be sent out into the world in Jesus' name. That season has passed with the latest changes made by the fairground. In years past, our church has been known for its great commitment to missions. We are still passionate about

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missions. We will just have to fund our mission partners in different ways. It is going to take some creativity and tireless effort and commitment.

Without money from the fair, we will need to work individually to set aside something to give to missions. So, when you hear a call to support a particular mission and an offering is collected, be ready to give. Take each request seriously. Instead of giving hours out at the fairgrounds, spend time working to come up with new ideas to support missions. Set aside a little each week for the next missions offering we collect. And, when you see a sign-up sheet, commit to doing the work necessary to support the ministries of the church.

We will also have a Trustee fundraiser in November. Please support the upkeep of our buildings and grounds by joining in. Be watching for more info on that, and be the first to sign-up to help. You can help by making and serving take-out meals, donating desserts, cooking in the kitchen, taking food out to cars, and staying to help clean up afterwards. It will take the whole church to make the next meal a success.

As you support the mission causes you believe in, be sure to remain faithful in your support of the church as well. Remember that missions giving is above and beyond your tithing to the church. Tithing is giving 10% of what you have received from the Lord. That is given first. Firstfruits given to the Lord. Second, offerings are collected and distributed to other ministries through sacrificial giving. That means, you surrender or sacrifice something that is yours to benefit someone else. Meet the needs of others. Support the mission work of the church.

Please listen for specific special offerings we plan to collect (probably on a monthly basis) and plan accordingly. Give, from a grateful heart, for the Lord has given generously to you. Amen.

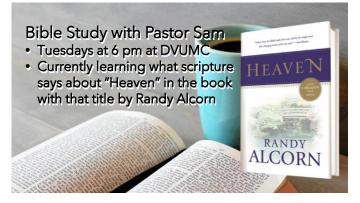

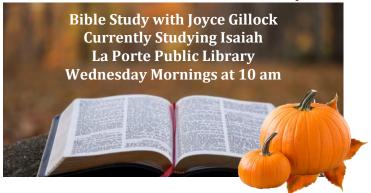
