Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good; his love endures forever. ~ 1 Chronicles 16:34

Grateful people give. They give their thanks and praise to the Lord. Grateful people give. They bring offerings to God. In November, we celebrate Thanksgiving Sunday. A day set aside to remember and give thanks to God. It is no coincidence that the months of October and November were selected to celebrate God's blessings. They are the months when crops are ready for harvest and food is most abundant. Food is stored for the coming winter, and... food is shared with those we love. That love extends to the One who provides the sun and the rain, the soil and the seed. The One who created... everything. Not that God needs what we offer in praise and thanksgiving; God needs nothing. It is more about what we need. We need to bring our praise offering to God. He is worthy of all our thanks and praise.

Great is the Lord, and most worthy of praise ~ Psalm 48:1

I have a request to make of you. It is more like an encouragement or a teachable moment. During the month of October, pray to God for a grateful heart. Ask Him to open your eyes to see His blessings. Then, in the month of November, I want each person to make a special praise offering to God. It is simple. Above and beyond your regular tithing or giving, make a one-time praise offering to God. If the Lord has abundantly blessed you, then it will flow from that blessing. It is not hard to come up with ways that God has provided for you in this past year.

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Be creative and challenge yourself. Give a ridiculous amount. A one-time praise offering. In times of abundant harvest, it is a joy to express gratitude to God through an additional gift to God.

For some, this will be a sacrificial gift – giving up something or going without something in order to show your surrender and gratitude to:

God who supplies all our needs according to His riches in glory ~ Philippians 4:19

One more thing I ask of you. Include a note of gratitude. I would like to share some of what you wrote on Thanksgiving Sunday, November 24. I will not include your name (if you indicate that), just your words of gratitude. Place your one-time, thankful offering with your note of thanksgiving to God in an envelope labeled "Thankful," and place it in the offering plate by November 17. Or drop it off in the office. For those who join us online, send it in the mail or use the online giving portal. Be generous because God is generous. Be blessed because God blesses those who bless His Holy Name. Be thankful. Because God deserves nothing less than our continual praise. Be generous in your gift to the Lord for He is generous to us.

I will extol the Lord at all times; his praise will always be on my lips. ~ Psalm 34:1

So, do it right now. Get out an envelope. Consider carefully your gift. Be generous, be grateful, be committed, be a follower of Jesus Christ who is saved by the great sacrifice He made. Even His life on the cross for our sins. Praise the Lord – He is worthy of all our thanks and praise. Or even better, pray about it. Talk it over with those you love and trust. Know this – your gifts (great and small) count for the kingdom of heaven. Give thanks, with a grateful heart, to God.


