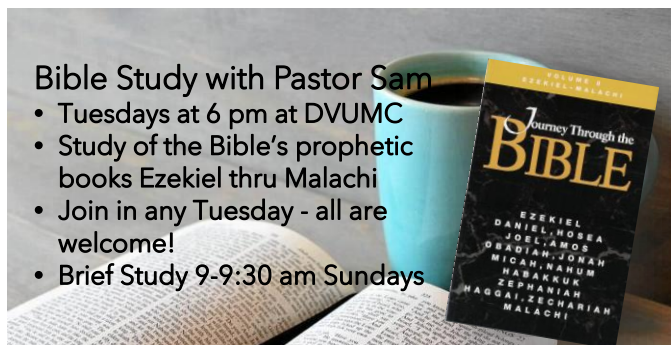

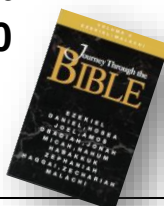
- 2025 LP County Fair Vacation Bible School

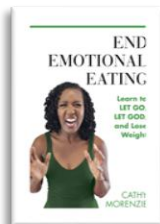

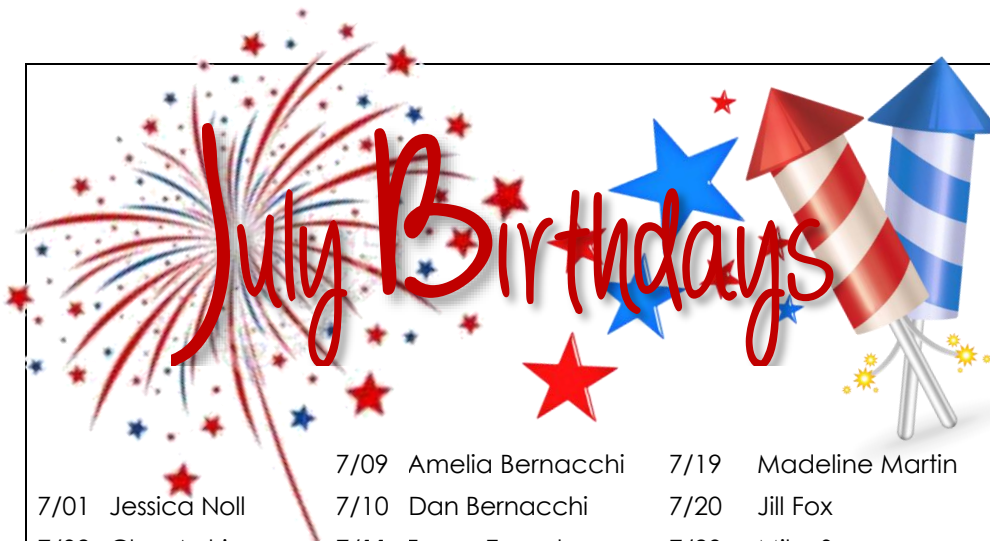
